Meeting Minutes

The Product Design Group provided market parties with an update on the implementation of the Transfer of Energy (ToE) roadmap and the evolution of the Flex Data Hub platform. It was supported by a slide deck, which can be found on the webpage of the PDG¹. These meeting minutes capture the interactions between the participants.

ToE roadmap

System operators confirmed that the ToE Gameplan is being implemented through the rollout of the CSM, while investigations on the Corrected Model (CM) are ongoing with the Belgian Competition Authority.

During the discussion, Vincent Deblocq asked whether additional information is available from the CREG regarding competitiveness problem on CM. Philippe explained that this relates to the fact that, under the CM, certain sensitive data may need to be shared between market actors, which could raise concerns from a competitiveness perspective. Michael Van Bossuyt noted that he hopes the topic of Corrected Model will move forward and asked that the market be kept informed of further developments on this topic. Elia acknowledged this request.

It was also noted that system operators are still waiting for the Walloon regulatory update concerning aFRR and the FSP-DSO contract.

Flex Data Hub updates

Participants were informed about the upcoming Flex Data Hub releases, including the modernisation release planned for 25 March and the ToE release currently under development, with testing by FSPs foreseen in Q2 2026.

Two main releases were presented:

- **Flex Data Hub – Phase 1 (Modernisation Release):** Tests are ready and the deployment remains on track for 25 March 2026. This release mainly concerns the technical modernisation of the platform and has limited impact on market parties.
- **Flex Data Hub – Phase 2 (ToE Release):** The release implementing the ToE-related changes (including a new user interface) is ongoing. A call for testing will be launched for FSPs in Q2 2026.

Participants were also informed about a change of domain name linked to the platform.

Additional remarks

In addition, system operators highlighted that further work is ongoing on congestion management and balancing products, including work on the future Document Release 4, and that they continue investing in the development of local flexibility markets including the context of the upcoming Network Code Demand Response
